

## Homework Expectations 2022-23

### Aims

Homework is an integral part of education in that it:

- Promotes students' self-discipline and personal responsibility for learning and organisation.
- Reinforces work started in class, extending knowledge and understanding.
- Gives opportunities to practise and develop skills.
- Allows parents to become involved in their child's learning.
- Is valuable in ensuring students' progress and raising achievement.

### Amount of Homework

- For all Key Stage 3 subjects, homework should equate to one hour and set at the frequency outlined below.

<b>Key Stage 3</b>	<b>English, Maths, Science</b>	<b>Languages</b>	<b>Humanities</b>	<b>Art, Technology, PE, ICT, TD, Performing Arts, Music</b>
	Weekly	Fortnightly	Fortnightly	Fortnightly

- For all Key Stage 4 subjects, homework should equate to 2 hours per subject and set at the frequency outlined below.

<b>Key Stage 4</b>	<b>English, Maths, Science 2 hours</b>	<b>All other subjects 1 hour</b>
	Weekly	Fortnightly

- For all Key Stage 5 subjects, homework should equate to 3 hours per subject and set at the frequency outlined below.

<b>Key Stage 5</b>	<b>All subjects</b>
	Weekly

### The role of students

- Take responsibility for learning and submit completed work in a timely manner.
- Make sure they understand the tasks that have been set and seek clarification if required.
- Take pride in the presentation and content of their homework and perform to a high standard.
